



Grapes from California 2010 Foodservice Chef Recipe Contest

OFFICIAL RULES

BY ENTERING THE CONTEST YOU (“Contestant”) AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- **Effect of Rules:** By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of the California Table Grape Commission (“**Sponsor**”), which shall be final and binding in all respects.
- **Eligibility:** The contest is open to any foodservice chef in the U.S. and Canada, including educators, 18 years or older. Employees of Sponsor, their affiliates, promotional agencies and their families are not eligible. Contest offer is void where prohibited by law or company policy.
- **Ownership and Use:** All entries and recipes will become the property of Sponsor as of the date of submission to Sponsor, and will not be returned.
 - Sponsor reserves the right to adapt, modify, edit, publish, distribute in all forms of media, both domestic and foreign, license, sell and otherwise use the recipes as Sponsor may from time to time elect.
 - Contestant agrees to the use of his/her name, photo and recipe submission in any form of publicity or trade promotion purposed by sponsor. However, Contestant acknowledges that he/she has no right to have recipes publicized or otherwise used by Sponsor in any way, or to be named or otherwise identified in connection with any recipes.
- **Limitation of Liability:** Sponsor is not responsible for printing or typographical errors in contest-related materials or publicity; or for stolen, lost, late, misdirected, damaged, incomplete or illegible entries. Additionally, Sponsor is not responsible for entries not received, or for undeliverable, filtered or otherwise delayed or lost emails/mails that prevent a recipe from arriving to enter the contest or a notification to get to a winner after the contest.
- **Interpretation and Enforcement:** These rules shall be interpreted and enforced, and the contest governed, according to the laws of the State of California applicable to contracts made and to be performed entirely within this State. In the event of any dispute concerning these rules or the contest, venue shall lie solely in the state or federal courts located in Fresno County, California. These rules shall not be strictly construed against either party.



TO ENTER:

- Entries must be received by Sponsor no earlier than July 1, 2010 and no later than 5 p.m. (Pacific Time) on November 1, 2010.
- Contestant may enter as many recipes as he/she desires, but each recipe entered must comply with the following requirements.
- Suggested categories include starters, small plates, entrees, salads, sides and desserts, but entrants may create their own category. Sponsor reserves the right to move an entry into a different category/classification if deemed appropriate.
- Entries must be in English and include standard U.S. weights and measures and include a complete list of ingredients, complete preparation directions, pan sizes, cooking times and temperature, yield, and (if applicable) appropriate safe handling instructions.
- Each recipe must be typed and formatted for 8 1/2 X 11-inch size paper, then submitted electronically or mailed to Sponsor as noted below. All entries must be accompanied by a completed **Entry Form** (see below).
- All recipes entered shall be original creations of Contestant, and previously unpublished. Contestant shall indemnify, defend, and hold Sponsor harmless from any claim that a recipe entered violates the copyright or other rights of any third person.

PRIZES:

- One first prize of \$1,500; one second prize of \$1000; and one third prize of \$500 will be awarded.
- The decision of the judges appointed by Sponsor shall be final in all aspects as to this contest.
- All federal, state and local taxes, license fees, applicable sales taxes and other fees are the sole responsibility of the winners of prizes awarded.
- There will be no substitutions of prizes as offered except at the discretion of sponsor. Prizes are non-transferable.

HOW WINNERS ARE DETERMINED:

- Eligible entries will be judged on five criteria: 1) use of California grapes; 2) applicability for use in restaurants/foodservice; 3) taste; 4) overall appeal; and 5) creativity.
